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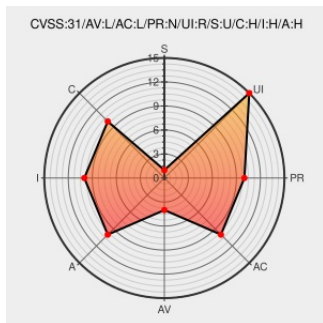

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Certain versions of [Cx-programmer](#) from [Omron](#) contain the following vulnerability:

OMRON CX-Programmer 9.78 and prior is vulnerable to an Out-of-Bounds Write, which may allow an attacker to execute arbitrary code.

CVE-2022-3398 has been assigned by [ics-cert@hq.dhs.gov](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
