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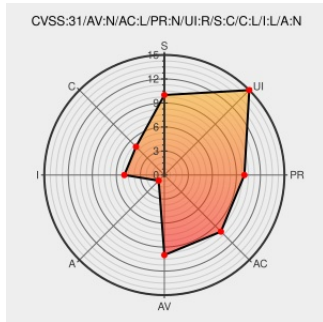

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Certain versions of **Pmb** from **Pmb Project** contain the following vulnerability:

PMB 7.3.10 allows reflected XSS via the id parameter in an `lvl=author_see` request to `index.php`.

CVE-2022-34328 has been assigned by [M](#) `cve@mitre.org` to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
