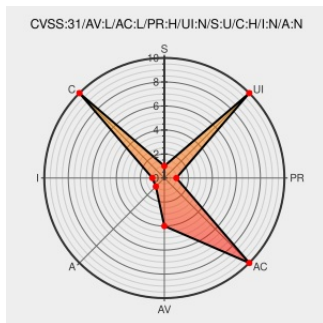

Certain versions of **Powerscale Onefs** from **Dell** contain the following vulnerability:

Dell PowerScale OneFS, versions 8.2.x through 9.3.x contain a weak encoding for a password. A malicious local privileged attacker may potentially exploit this vulnerability, leading to information disclosure.

CVE-2022-34445 has been assigned by secure@dell.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
