

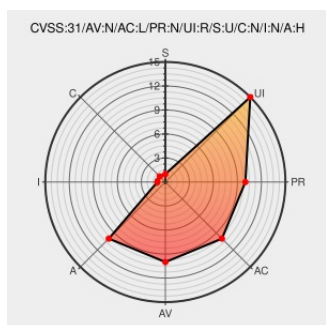

Certain versions of [Otfcc](#) from [Otfcc Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

OTFCC commit 617837b was discovered to contain a heap buffer overflow via `/release-x64/otfccdump+0x6c0414`.

CVE-2022-35059 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

CVSS3 Score: **6.5 - MEDIUM**
