

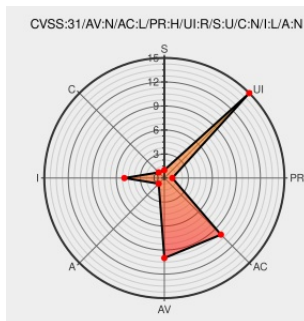

Certain versions of [Sanitization Management System](#) from [Sanitization Management System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability classified as problematic has been found in SourceCodester Sanitization Management System 1.0. Affected is an unknown function of the component User Creation Handler. The manipulation of the argument First Name/Middle Name/Last Name leads to cross site scripting. It is possible to launch the attack remotely.

VDB-211014 is the identifier assigned to this vulnerability.

CVE-2022-3518 has been assigned by [cna@vuldb.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
