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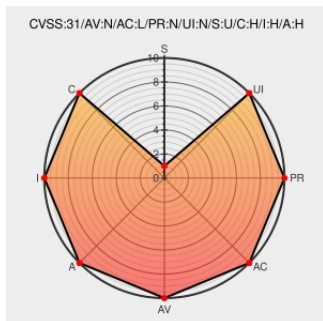

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Certain versions of [Inventorymanagementsystem](#) from [Inventorymanagementsystem Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A SQL injection vulnerability in UserDAO.java in sazanrjb InventoryManagementSystem 1.0 allows attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the parameters such as 'users', 'pass', etc.

CVE-2022-35605 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
