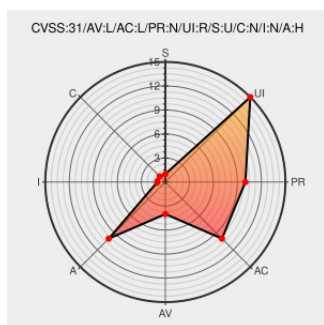

tifig v0.2.2 was discovered to contain a heap-buffer overflow via `__asan_memmove` at `/asan/asan_interceptors_memintrinsics.cpp`.
