

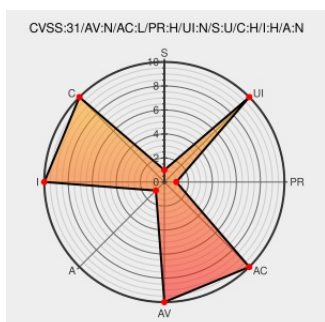

Certain versions of [Edoc-doctor-appointment-system](#) from [Edoc-doctor-appointment-system Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An access control issue in the component `/ip/admin/` of Edoc-doctor-appointment-system v1.0.1 allows attackers to arbitrarily edit, read, and delete Administrator data.

CVE-2022-36542 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
