

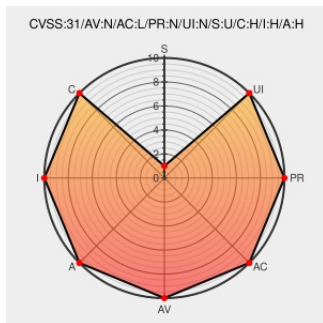

Certain versions of [Library Management System](#) from [Library Management System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Library Management System v1.0 was discovered to contain a SQL injection vulnerability via the bookId parameter at /admin/delete.php.

CVE-2022-36735 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.

CVSS3 Score: **9.8 - CRITICAL**
