

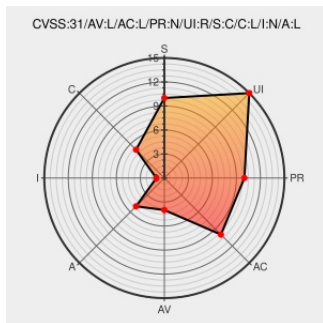

Certain versions of [Samsung Pay](#) from [Samsung](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Pending Intent hijacking vulnerability in SpayNotification in Samsung Pay prior to version 5.0.63 for KR and 5.1.47 for Global allows attackers to access files without permission via implicit Intent.

CVE-2022-36872 has been assigned by [S](#) [mobile.security@samsung.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
