

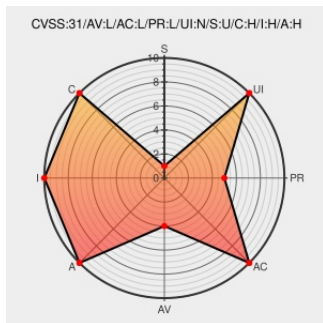

TOTOLINK A7000R V9.1.0u.6115_B20201022 was discovered to contain a stack overflow via the pppoeUser parameter.

CVE-2022-37077 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
