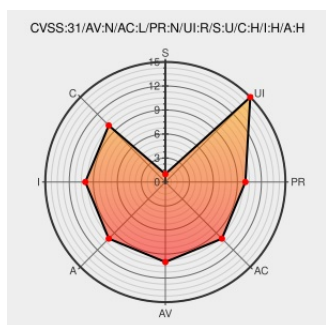

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Certain versions of [Ftcms](#) from [Ftcms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In [ftcms 2.1](#), there is a Cross Site Request Forgery (CSRF) vulnerability in the PHP page, which causes the attacker to forge a link to trick him to click on a malicious link or visit a page containing attack code, and send a request to the server (corresponding to the identity authentication information) as the victim without the victim's

knowledge.

CVE-2022-37730 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
