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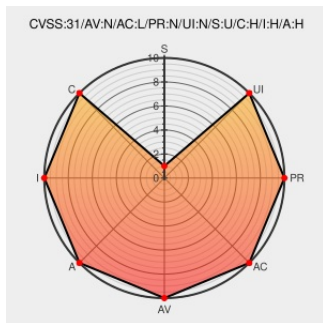
CVE-2022-37803

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Certain versions of [Ac1206](#) from [Tenda](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Tenda AC1206 V15.03.06.23 was discovered to contain a stack overflow via the page parameter in the function fromAddressNat.

CVE-2022-37803 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
