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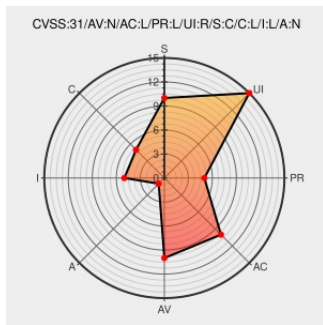

Silverstripe silverstripe/framework through 4.11 allows XSS (issue 3 of 3).
