

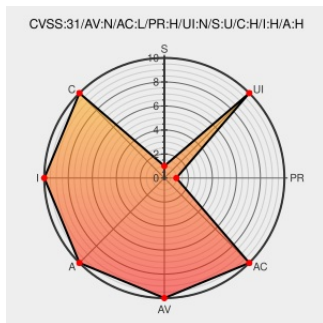

Certain versions of [Online Leave Management System](#) from [Online Leave Management System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Online Leave Management System v1.0 was discovered to contain a SQL injection vulnerability via the id parameter at /maintenance/manage_leave_type.php.

CVE-2022-38304 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
