

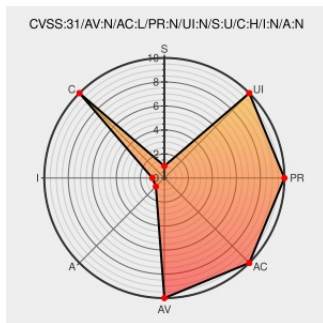

Certain versions of [Smartvista Cardgen](#) from [Bpcb](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue in the IGB Files and OutfileService features of SmartVista Cardgen v3.28.0 allows attackers to list and download arbitrary files via modifying the PATH parameter.

CVE-2022-38614 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
