

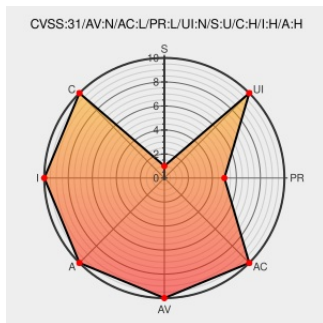

Certain versions of [Ywoa](#) from [Yimihome](#) contain the following vulnerability:

ywoa v6.1 is vulnerable to SQL Injection via backend/oa/visual/exportExcel.do interface.

CVE-2022-38808 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
