Description	Discourse is an open source discussion platform. In versions prior to 2.8.9 on the `stable` branch and prior to 2.9.0.beta10 on the `beta` branch, the user profile location and website fields were not sufficiently length-limited, allowing an attacker to bypass the length limit and inject arbitrary HTML/JavaScript into the user profile. This could be used to perform a cross-site scripting (XSS) attack.
