

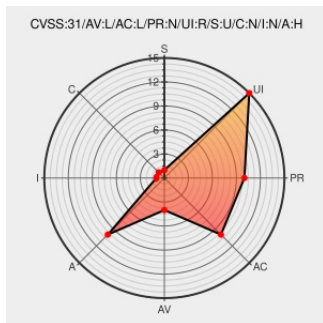

Bento4 1.6.0 has memory leaks via the mp4fragment.
