

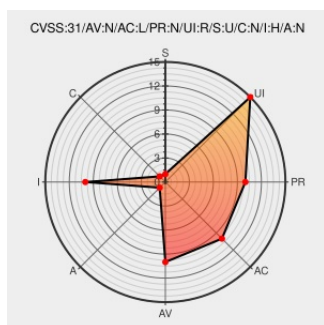

Certain versions of [Rpcms](#) from [Rpcms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

RPCMS v3.0.2 was discovered to contain a Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF) which allows attackers to arbitrarily change the password of any account.

CVE-2022-41474 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
