

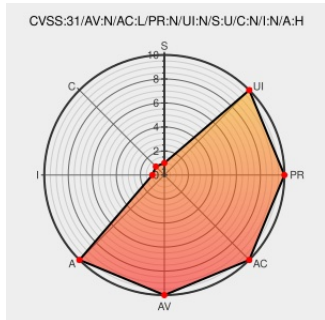

LINE client for iOS before 12.17.0 might be crashed by sharing an invalid shared key of e2ee in group chat.
