

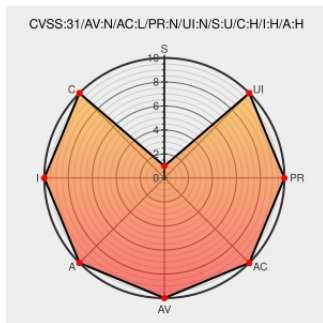

Certain versions of [Svmcp1](#) from [Daikinlatam](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Daikin SVMPC1 version 2.1.22 and prior and SVMPC2 version 1.2.3 and prior are vulnerable to an attacker obtaining user login credentials and control the system.

CVE-2022-41653 has been assigned by [ics-cert@hq.dhs.gov](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
