Certain versions of [Chained Quiz](#) from [Kibokolabs](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Chained Quiz plugin for WordPress is vulnerable to Reflected Cross-Site Scripting via the 'datef' parameter on the 'chainedquiz_list' page in versions up to, and including, 1.3.2 due to insufficient input sanitization and output escaping. This makes it possible for unauthenticated attackers to inject arbitrary web scripts in pages that

execute if they can successfully trick a user into performing an action such as clicking on a link.

CVE-2022-4208 has been assigned by [security@wordfence.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
