Certain versions of [Experience Manager](#) from [Adobe](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Adobe Experience Manager version 6.5.14 (and earlier) is affected by a reflected Cross-Site Scripting (XSS) vulnerability. If a low-privileged attacker is able to convince a victim to visit a URL referencing a vulnerable page, malicious JavaScript content may be executed within the context of the victim's browser.

CVE-2022-42357 has been assigned by [psirt@adobe.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
