

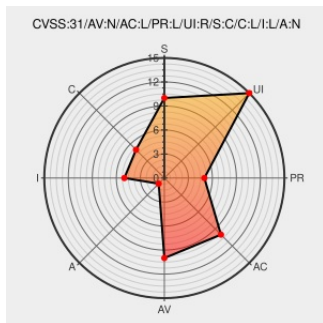

Certain versions of [Password Storage Application](#) from [Password Storage Application Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Sourcecodester Password Storage Application in PHP/OOP and MySQL 1.0 was discovered to contain multiple cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerabilities via the Name, Username, Description and Site Feature parameters.

CVE-2022-43117 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
