

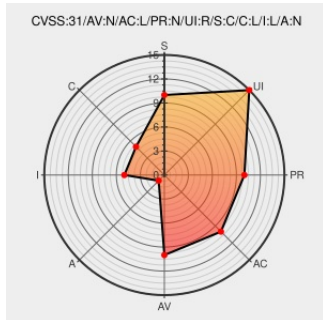

Certain versions of [Post Status Notifier Lite](#) from [lfeelweb](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Post Status Notifier Lite WordPress plugin before 1.10.1 does not sanitise and escape a parameter before outputting it back in the page, leading to a Reflected Cross-Site Scripting which can be used against high privilege users such as admin.

CVE-2022-4325 has been assigned by contact@wpscan.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Unknown - Post Status Notifier Lite** version = 0

CVSS3 Score: **6.1 - MEDIUM**
