

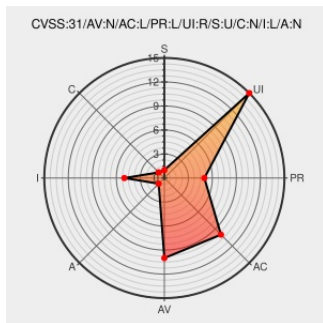

Certain versions of [Pb-cms](#) from [Pb-cms Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability has been found in LinZhaoguan pb-cms 2.0 and classified as problematic. Affected by this vulnerability is the function IpUtil.getIpAddr. The manipulation leads to cross site scripting. The attack can be launched remotely. The exploit has been disclosed to the public and may be used. The identifier VDB-215113 was assigned to

this vulnerability.

CVE-2022-4353 has been assigned by [cna@vuldb.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
