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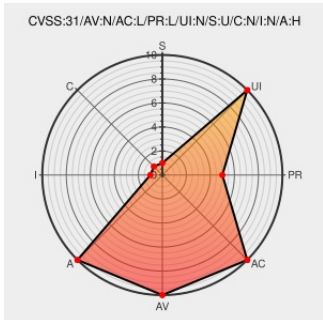

Certain versions of [Concrete Cms](#) from [Concretecms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In Concrete CMS (formerly concrete5) below 8.5.10 and between 9.0.0 and 9.1.2, the `authTypeConcreteCookieMap` table can be filled up causing a denial of service (high load).

CVE-2022-43686 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
