Certain versions of [Concrete Cms](#) from [Concretecms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Concrete CMS is vulnerable to CSRF due to the lack of "State" parameter for external Concrete authentication service for users of Concrete who use the "out of the box" core OAuth.

CVE-2022-43693 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
