Netgear R7000P V1.3.0.8 is vulnerable to Buffer Overflow in `/usr/sbin/httpd` via parameter `wan_dns1_sec`.

CVE-2022-44184 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
