

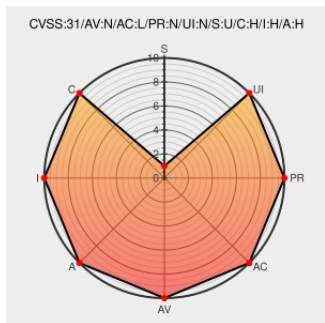

Certain versions of [R7000p](#) from [Netgear](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Netgear R7000P V1.3.0.8 is vulnerable to Buffer Overflow in `/usr/sbin/httpd` via parameter `enable_band_steering`.

CVE-2022-44188 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
