

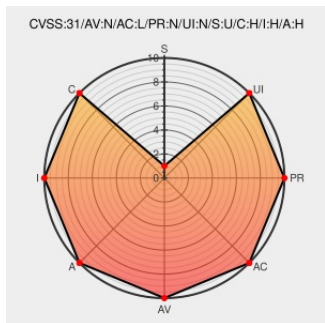

Certain versions of **Emui** from **Huawei** contain the following vulnerability:

The AMS module has a vulnerability of serialization/deserialization mismatch. Successful exploitation of this vulnerability may cause privilege escalation.
