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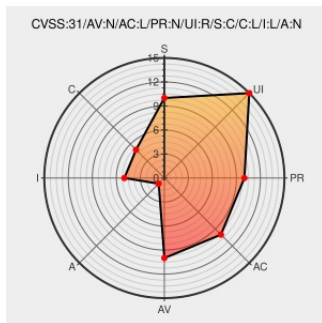

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Certain versions of [Iguana](#) from [Axiell](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A reflected XSS vulnerability has been found in Axiell Iguana CMS, allowing an attacker to execute code in a victim's browser. The module parameter on the Service.template.cls endpoint does not properly neutralise user input, resulting in the vulnerability.

CVE-2022-45051 has been assigned by csirt@divd.nl to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Axiell** - **Iguana** version = < 4.5.02

CVSS3 Score: **6.1 - MEDIUM**
