

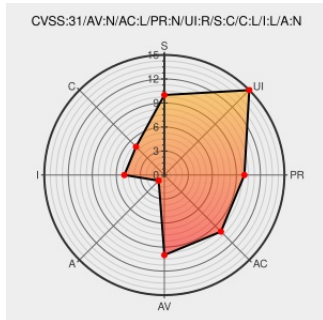

Certain versions of [Django Terms And Conditions](#) from [Django Terms And Conditions Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability has been found in cyface Terms and Conditions Module up to 2.0.9 and classified as problematic. Affected by this vulnerability is the function returnTo of the file termsandconditions/views.py. The manipulation leads to open redirect. The attack can be launched remotely. Upgrading to version 2.0.10 is able to address this issue. The

name of the patch is 03396a1c2e0af95e12a45c5faef7e47a4b513e1a. It is recommended to upgrade the affected component. The associated identifier of this vulnerability is VDB-216175.

CVE-2022-4589 has been assigned by [cna@vuldb.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
