

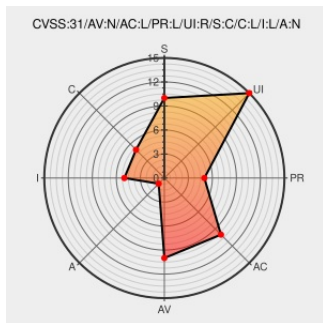

Certain versions of [Cloudschool](#) from [Cloudschool Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

CloudSchool v3.0.1 is vulnerable to Cross Site Scripting (XSS). A normal user can steal session cookies of the admin users through notification received by the admin user.

CVE-2022-46087 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

CVSS3 Score: **5.4 - MEDIUM**
