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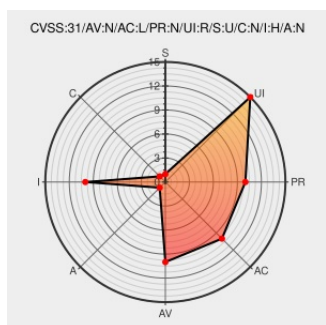

Certain versions of [Nbnbk](#) from [Nbnbk Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF) vulnerability in the Add Administrator function of the default version of nbnbk allows attackers to arbitrarily add Administrator accounts.

CVE-2022-46491 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
