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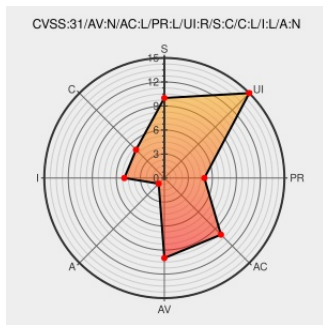

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Certain versions of [Hashbar](#) from [Hasthemes](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The HashBar WordPress plugin before 1.3.6 does not validate and escape one of its shortcode attributes, which could allow users with a role as low as contributor to perform Stored Cross-Site Scripting attack.

CVE-2022-4650 has been assigned by [contact@wpscan.com](mailto:contact@wpscan.com) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
