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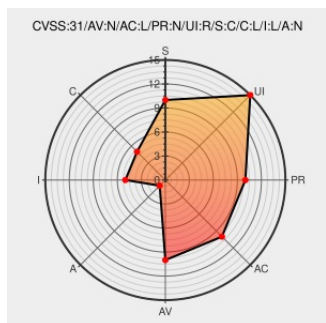

Certain versions of [Kkfileview](#) from [Keking](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability, which was classified as problematic, has been found in kkFileView. Affected by this issue is the function setWatermarkAttribute of the file /picturesPreview. The manipulation leads to cross site scripting. The attack may be launched remotely. The exploit has been disclosed to the public and may be used. The identifier of this

vulnerability is VDB-216776.

CVE-2022-4740 has been assigned by cna@vuldb.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

CVSS3 Score: **6.1 - MEDIUM**
