Description	The WP Tiles WordPress plugin through 1.1.2 does not validate and escape some of its shortcode attributes before outputting them to the browser. An attacker can inject arbitrary HTML and JavaScript into the page output, which can be used to perform various attacks, including phishing, defacement, and data theft.
