Description	A SQL injection vulnerability exists in the “message viewer print” feature of the ScienceLogic SL1 that takes unsanitized user input and injects it into the SQL query. An attacker can exploit this vulnerability to execute arbitrary SQL commands and potentially gain access to sensitive data.
