Description	The Naver Map WordPress plugin through 1.1.0 does not validate and escape some of its shortcode attributes before outputting them. An attacker could inject malicious code into the page, which would be executed by the browser. This could lead to a remote code execution (RCE) vulnerability. The vulnerability is located in the shortcode function, which does not properly sanitize the input before outputting it. The vulnerability is present in versions 1.1.0 and earlier.
