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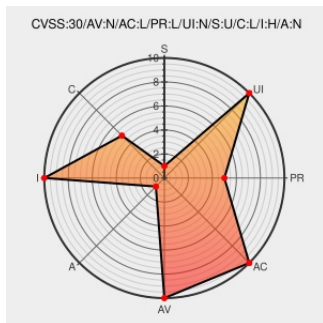

Weak Password Requirements in GitHub repository thorsten/phpmyfaq prior to 3.1.11.
