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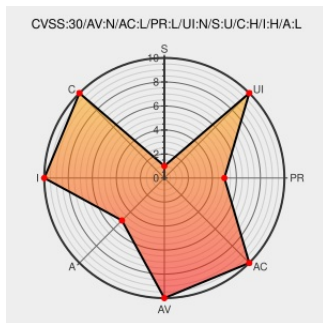

Cross-site Scripting (XSS) - Stored in GitHub repository thorsten/phpmyfaq prior to 3.1.11.

CVE-2023-0794 has been assigned by security@huntr.dev to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
