

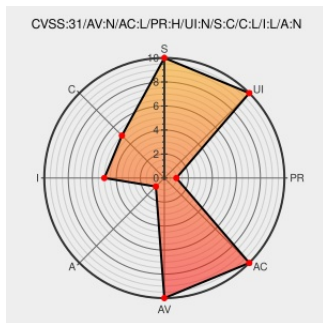

Certain versions of [Hotjar](#) from [Hotjar](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Hotjar plugin for WordPress is vulnerable to Stored Cross-Site Scripting via the `hotjar_site_id` in versions up to, and including, 1.0.15 due to insufficient input sanitization and output escaping. This makes it possible for authenticated attackers, with administrator-level permissions and above, to inject arbitrary web scripts in pages that will

execute whenever a user accesses an injected page. This only affects multi-site installations and installations where `unfiltered_html` has been disabled.

CVE-2023-1259 has been assigned by [security@wordfence.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
