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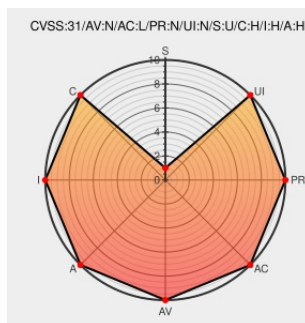

Certain versions of [Simple Bakery Shop Management System](#) from [Simple Bakery Shop Management System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability, which was classified as critical, has been found in SourceCodester Simple Bakery Shop Management System 1.0. Affected by this issue is some unknown functionality of the component Admin Login. The manipulation of the argument username/password

with the input admin' or 1=1 -- leads to sql injection. The attack may be launched remotely. The exploit has been disclosed to the public and may be used. The identifier of this vulnerability is VDB-222860.

CVE-2023-1357 has been assigned by cna@vuldb.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: SourceCodester - Simple Bakery Shop Management System version = 1.0
