

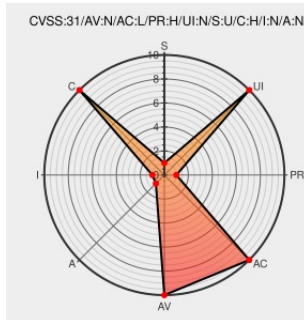

Certain versions of [Employee Payslip Generator System](#) from [Employee Payslip Generator System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability was found in SourceCodester Employee Payslip Generator with Sending Mail 1.2.0 and classified as critical. This issue affects some unknown processing of the file classes/Users.php?f=save of the component New User Creation. The manipulation of the

argument username leads to sql injection. The attack may be initiated remotely. The exploit has been disclosed to the public and may be used. The associated identifier of this vulnerability is VDB-222863.

CVE-2023-1360 has been assigned by cna@vuldb.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **SourceCodester - Employee Payslip Generator with Sending Mail** version = 1.2.0

CVSS3 Score: **4.9 - MEDIUM**
