Certain versions of [Police Crime Record Management System](#) from [Police Crime Record Management System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability was found in SourceCodester Police Crime Record Management System 1.0. It has been classified as critical. This affects an unknown part of the file /officer/assigncase.php of the component GET Parameter Handler. The manipulation of the argument caseid

leads to sql injection. It is possible to initiate the attack remotely. The exploit has been disclosed to the public and may be used. The identifier VDB-224745 was assigned to this vulnerability.

CVE-2023-1793 has been assigned by cna@vuldb.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
