

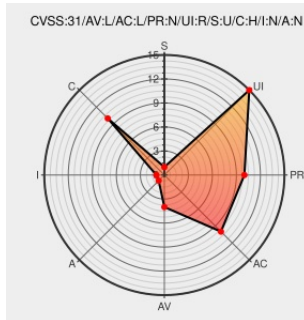

Certain versions of [Bridge](#) from [Adobe](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Adobe Bridge versions 12.0.3 (and earlier) and 13.0.1 (and earlier) are affected by an out-of-bounds read vulnerability that could lead to disclosure of sensitive memory. An attacker could leverage this vulnerability to bypass mitigations such as ASLR. Exploitation of this issue requires user interaction in that a victim must open a malicious

file.

CVE-2023-22231 has been assigned by psirt@adobe.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
