

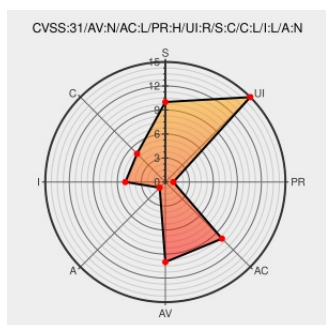

Certain versions of [Srx5308](#) from [Netgear](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability was found in Netgear SRX5308 up to 4.3.5-3. It has been rated as problematic. This issue affects some unknown processing of the file `scgi-bin/platform.cgi?page=ike_policies.htm` of the component Web Management Interface. The manipulation of the argument `IpsecIKEPolicy.IKEPolicyName` leads to cross site scripting.

The attack may be initiated remotely. The exploit has been disclosed to the public and may be used. The associated identifier of this vulnerability is VDB-227663. NOTE: The vendor was contacted early about this disclosure but did not respond in any way.

CVE-2023-2385 has been assigned by [cna@vuldb.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
