

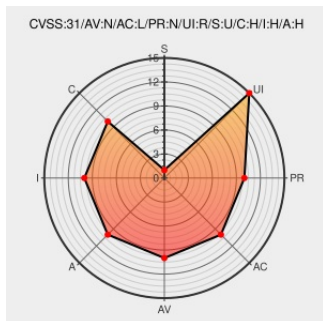

Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF) vulnerability in Dave Jesch Database Collation Fix plugin <= 1.2.7 versions.
